ESTABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL PENSIONS COLLEGE AND TRUSTEES TRAINING

The National Pensions Regulatory Authority (NPRA) wishes to inform all Trustees and other Service Providers that the Authority has established a **National Pensions College** (NPC) to train all Trustees and Service Providers in the industry. As a result of that, all members of the Schemes' Board of Trustees who are yet to undergo the required basic training, are to contact the Secretariat of the College to be trained.

All such Trustees (Corporate, Individual & Independent) are therefore advised to take note and enrol with the National Pensions College to obtain the necessary skills and knowledge required for effective administration of Schemes under their management, in compliance with the National Pensions Act, 2008 (Act 766).

The public who are interested in working in the pensions industry are also encouraged to take advantage of this notice to enrol and be trained.

Below are the modules of the mandatory Certificate in Pensions Administration programme and the Training Timetable for the last quarter of the year, 2022:

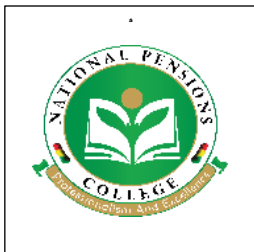
